

Directions to the School

From the South or North via the M1

Leave the Motorway at Junction 18 (Crick), driving towards Rugby. Filter left at next roundabout following signs for A428 Rugby – at second roundabout keep straight on (Eddie Stobart on left) – at the third roundabout (Halfway House public house) keep straight on (A428 Rugby). Stay on this road for approximately 5 miles. Cross straight over traffic lights, pass the Memorial Gates in front of Rugby Recreation Ground on your left, and drive straight over the next roundabout. (You are now on the large map overleaf, approaching along Hillmorton Road).

From the M6

Exit Motorway at Junction 1 and follow signs for A426 Rugby. Continue straight on until you reach the fourth roundabout (Tesco on your left) go straight on. At the fifth roundabout bear left (Newbold Road) and pass under railway bridge and then up the hill. Passing the Police station on your left, go straight over the next roundabout into Corporation Street (dual carriageway), and left at next set of traffic lights (William Webb Ellis public house will be on your left). Keep in left-hand lane after lights (you will see Rugby School straight ahead). Follow the road round to the left. (You are now on the large map overleaf).

From the A14

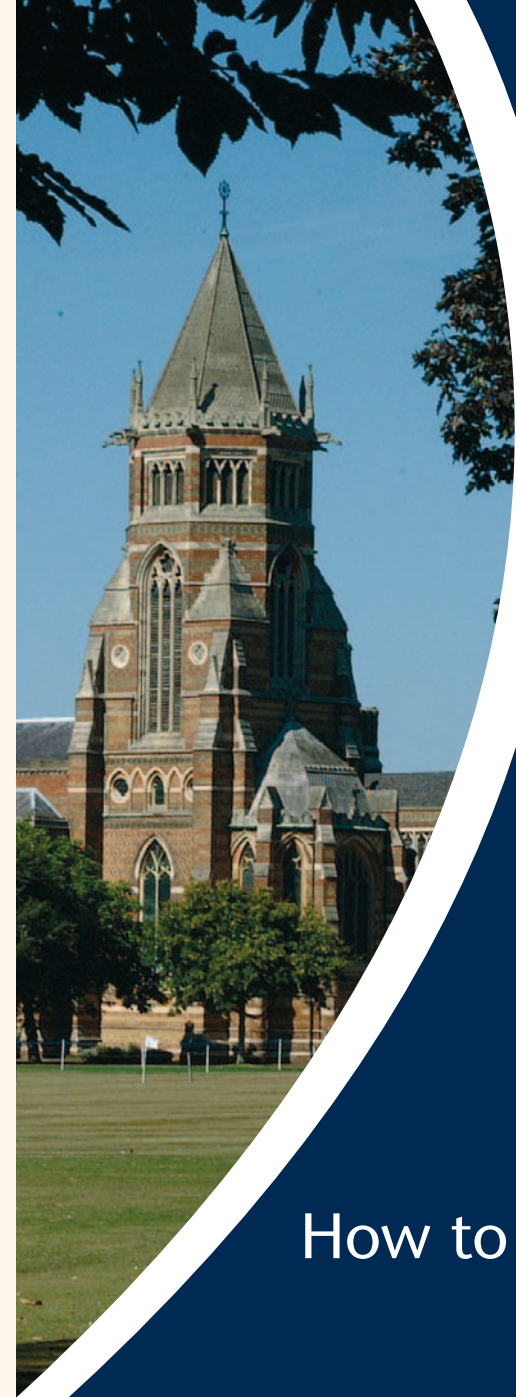
At the A14/M1/M6 junction follow the signs for Birmingham M6. Join the M6, leave at junction 1 and follow the directions above.

From the South West via the A45

At the A45/M45 junction bear left following signs for Dunchurch (B4429). Keep straight on until you reach the traffic lights. Turn left at lights (A426 Rugby). Keep on main road to the roundabout and then bear left. Drive straight over the next roundabout (Sainsbury's is on your right). After approximately 3 miles you will reach a one-way system. Keep to the right-hand lane (Russelsheim Way) until you reach the traffic lights (keep in right-hand lane filter). On exiting the lights, immediately cross over to the left-hand lane (William Webb Ellis public house will be on your left) and you see Rugby School straight ahead. Follow the road round to the left. (You are now on the large map overleaf).

By Air: Motorway links provide easy access to East Midland, Birmingham, London, Luton and Stanstead airports.

By Rail: Rugby is situated on the main line between Crewe, Birmingham and Euston.
